The ACU Guarantee, App FAQs and Offer FAQs pages will be updated before applications open this year. Guarantee your place at ACU, even before your Year 12 exams. The ACU Guarantee program offers eligible Year 12 students a place at ACU based on your Year 11 results.

Offers may be made as early as July. While successful applicants must still complete their Year 12 exams, you can do so secure in the knowledge that your marks from Year 11 meet our entry requirements. You may also enhance your entry score by including a short personal statement that gives ACU an insight into your personal circumstances and motivation for university study.

If your Year 11 results don't meet entry requirements, we will put you on our waiting list and automatically consider your application again based on your Year 12 results in the December/January offer rounds.

All direct applicants are required to meet the <u>co-</u> <u>curricular or service requirement</u> as part of their application.

All direct applicants will be covered by our <u>accommodation guarantee.</u>

For students who are interested in applying for scholarships, their eligibility is automatically assessed through our application process. There are two prestigious scholarships however that we want to call your attention to, these are the <u>Tuckwell</u> scholarship and the <u>Kambri Indigenous Undergraduate</u> <u>Scholarship</u>. Current Year 12 students can receive an Early Offer The Early Offer program allows Year 12 students to secure a place in a Southern Cross University degree before Year 12 results are released. It's designed to remove some of the pressure from Year 12 and provide a pathway directly into university study that is not based solely on Year 12 results.

Why should I apply for Early Offer?

This program allows you to gain an offer into a Southern Cross University course of your choice,* based on your high school grades and your school principal's recommendation.

Who is eligible?

Any student completing Year 12 studies at an Australian school in 2023 can apply.

How to apply. Here is how it works:

Your application must be completed in the one browser session.

Your school will then assess your application and make their recommendation according to Southern Cross University's guidelines.

If you're a current Year 12 student applying to UC for undergraduate study next year, you could receive an alternative early admission offer under the Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) using criteria other than your ATAR.

If you're a current Year 12 student, your school can recommend you for admission to the University of Canberra in advance of receiving your ATAR results, based on your abilities and success to date. Like your main application to UC, Schools Recommendation Scheme applications are also made through <u>UAC</u>. If you apply for the SRS, your school's rating of your aptitudes will be considered, including your capacity for tertiary study. Applying through the SRS doesn't guarantee you an offer to the University of Canberra, as course quotas and other criteria still need to be considered.

We care about more than just your ATAR Receive a conditional offer before the HSC results are released and benefit from a \$5,950 scholarship in your first year. We understand your ATAR may not always reflect your ability to do well at university or your interest or skills in a particular area. E12 is your chance to show us what makes you unique and what value you will bring to the University of Sydney. Your community involvement and activities you do outside of school tell us as much about you as your exam results do, so please share this in your E12 application. Your application for E12 is your opportunity to tell us more about yourself and what motivates you.

To be eligible for E12, you will need to be assessed by UAC via their <u>Educational Access Scheme</u>.

Complete the Educational Access Scheme (EAS) and SRS (Schools Recommendation Scheme) sections in UAC.

Ensure you submit any documentation needed in your EAS application.

Submit your E12 supporting document (answer to the three questions) in the SRS section and select the University of Sydney by the application close date. Place the course you wish to be considered for under E12 as your highest University of Sydney preference by the application close date.

Applications close: 11.59pm 15 September 2022. The course listed as your highest University of Sydney preference when applications close will be the course considered for your E12 application. 4

Sit your HSC exams and wait for your results. Conditional offers will be made in mid-November Ensure the course you've applied for is still in your preference list in UAC for the November SRS offer round.

Once you have received your ATAR in December, if you meet the conditions on your E12 conditional offer letter, including any additional admission criteria and have the course listed as your highest eligible preference in UAC, you will receive a formal unconditional offer.

If you haven't met the requirements of your E12 conditional offer, or if you've changed your mind about the course you wish to study, you can change your E12 course preference to be considered for an offer in UAC rounds once you've received your ATAR. If you've met the E12 ATAR and any other admission requirements of the new course, place it as your highest eligible preference and you'll receive an unconditional offer!*
