Instructions:

The people you will be designing a tour for will include 15 people. Of these 15 people:

- one is a staff member training to be a tour leader, who identifies as Aboriginal
- five people belong to migrant groups who have only recently arrived in Australia. These people come from Middle Eastern and Asian countries and their English language skills are limited
- one person has a physical disability, is wheelchair bound and is accompanied by her brother.

The written tour plan must address points 1-12 below and when answered must consider the three components outlined in the scenario: **cultural awareness**, **training of staff and disability adjustments**.

You may need to access the internet or use relevant textbooks to research social and cultural sensitivity and to assist you with designing the written tour plan.

The scenario outlined on the previous page has mentioned a large scale hospitality establishment. You, however, may prefer to focus on venues such as Sydney Tower, Fairmont Resort, Intercontinental, Panthers, William Blue, Rooty Hill RSL, SeaWorld Nara Resort and Crowne Plaza Hotels.

To complete this assessment, you will need to design a tour plan that outlines:

- 1. Areas of the establishment that you will visit in the tour (you could provide a list and/or show this on a map) and what resources you may need to utilise in the tour (e.g.: brochures, microphone).
- 2. Sources of information that you could access for communicating with colleagues and customers from diverse social and cultural groups.
- 3. How you will you ensure all guests feel welcome at the beginning of the tour?
- 4. What strategies will you implement to ensure that your colleague is well prepared prior to the tour commencing?
- 5. What methods you will use to ensure smooth and effective communication, so that participants gain maximum enjoyment and benefit from the tour?
- 6. What strategies will be implemented to deal with any language barriers?
- 7. How you will respond to any potential conflicts that may arise due to cultural misunderstandings and differences?
- 8. How you will ensure that the group's dietary and cultural requirements are met?
- 9. One of the members of your tour group makes a complaint about a foreign object in their meal (hair/fly). Outline how you would respond to this customer complaint.
- 10. Briefly explain how you would refer problems and unresolved issues to the GM at the conclusion of the tour.
- 11. How would you gauge or monitor the success of your tour?
- 12. Identify what policies and or procedures you may have to consider (Anti-Discrimination) when planning the tour.
