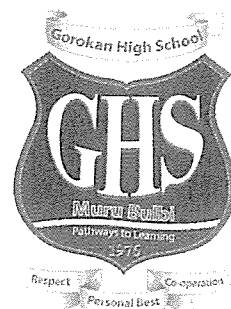

Your task is to investigate, design and present a snorkelling tour proposal for groups of local and overseas visitors that have booked with your company. You must address all safety concerns to provide an enjoyable snorkelling experience for your guests. Your task will be broken into the following 3 sections:

Section 1: Snorkelling site (6 marks)

Choose and investigate any snorkelling site in the world to take your tour group snorkelling. For example, the Great Barrier Reef or Fiji. Recommend the location, including map and accessibility of snorkelling site. Discuss the unique marine life with illustrations.

Section 2: Snorkelling Dangers (15 marks)

Discuss safety concerns when snorkelling such as rips and currents. Summarise **three** dangers associated with snorkelling including coral wounds, stings, bites, burns scalds, sunburn, sprains, seasickness and shock. Assess the first aid treatment for these dangers.

Section 3: Snorkelling safety (13 Marks)

Discuss DRSABCD in relation to a relevant snorkelling emergency. Recommend appropriate CPR that is relevant to a snorkelling emergency. Recommend a first aid kit needed for snorkelling emergencies. Recommend emergency contacts relevant to snorkelling.
