

### Online consent for Year 7 school vaccinations 2023

Dear parents/carers

As part of the NSW School Vaccination Program, Year 7 students are offered free vaccines for diphtheriatetanus-pertussis (dTpa) and human papillomavirus (HPV).

Central Coast Local Health District nurses will be at our school on **MONDAY 10 MARCH 2023.** You can now **provide online consent** for their routine school vaccinations. Vaccination will only be provided at school if consent has been received.



#### How to provide consent:

- To complete online consent for your child's school vaccinations, visit: https://nswhealth.service-now.com/school
- 2. Follow the steps to log in to your existing ServiceNSW account.

  This is the same account you may already use to renew your driver's licence.

  If you don't have a ServiceNSW account, refer to ServiceNSW to create one.
- 3. Update or confirm your personal details in ServiceNSW as required.
- 4. Complete the School Vaccination Consent Form for your child/ren. You will need to:
  - a) Enter your child's personal details
  - b) Provide the Medicare card details for you and your child
  - c) Read the linked Parent Information Sheet and privacy statement
  - d) Provide consent

If you or your child do not have a Medicare card, consent can still be provided by requesting a paper-based consent form. Please contact the school office on 4393 7000.

#### The benefits of providing consent online:

- easily update your child's details
- receive SMS and/or email notifications when vaccinations are given
- faster upload of vaccination records to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).

# **Uniform Exchange Program**

Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to 2023

The Gorokan High School Wellbeing Team will be working hard in 2023 to increase our student's school connections, school pride and community spirt. With your assistance we would encourage all students to attend each day in full school uniform.

When students wear school uniform, they feel they belong to the school. Wearing a uniform is an expression of pride, it creates identity for our school and is an important part of being a school student. Gorokan High School is a uniform school and is supported by our P&C.

In 2023, Gorokan High will be running a Uniform Exchange Program. If students arrive at school without the correct uniform they will be given a school uniform for the day. The process is as follows.

- Student will be expected to exchange their "out of uniform" item for a school uniform. This will be recorded within our Sentral system and parents will be notified.
- At the end of the school day students will collect their item and return the school uniform.
- The school uniform item will be washed and ironed ready for the next exchange.

Gorokan High School understands from time to time students will be unable to attend in full school uniform. The Uniform Exchange is not a negative consequence — it's a way of ensuring students feel connected to the school, proud of their uniform and continue to feel a part of the school community.

Our local community and P&C recognise our beautiful uniform and have consistently encouraged our students to wear uniform each day.

With your assistance of ensuring your child is dressed and organised for school each day we are positive 2023 will be a successful year.
