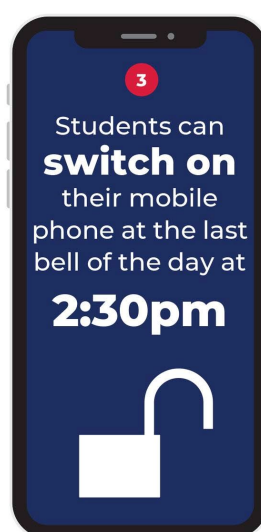
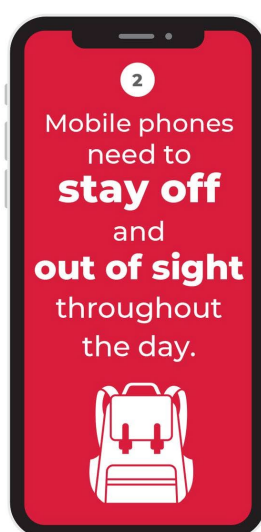
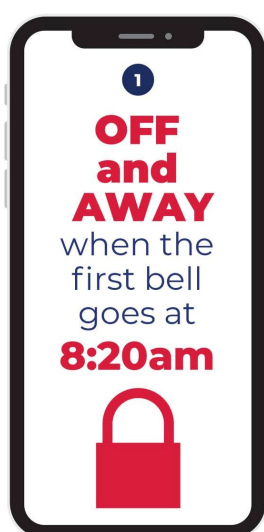


PBL Assembly Prize Draw Winners
